Strategy for Execution

- **The 3-Day Cycle:** Dedicate 2 days to intense study of the syllabus block, take the test on the morning of the 3rd day, and spend the afternoon analyzing your mistakes.
- **Prioritize Language & Math:** General Tamil/English and Aptitude make up 125 out of 200 questions (62.5% of the paper). Never skip studying these sections for a test, even if you fall behind on General Studies.
- **Targeted Analysis:** After every test, categorize your mistakes into three buckets: *Silly Mistakes*, *Memory Lapses*, and *Concept Gaps*. Fix the concept gaps before the next test.
- **Unit 8 & 9 Focus:** These two units are the highest-weightage areas in the General Studies section. Rely heavily on Thirukkural, Tamil society history, and TN government policy notes.
